

There were nearly 4.3 million nonfatal injuries and illnesses reported in 2004.

Injuries accounted for 4.0 million, or 94.2 percent, of all nonfatal injuries or illnesses.

The remainder of the cases (249,000) consisted of occupational illnesses.
