

Workplace Injuries and Illnesses Data Error



Nonfatal occupational injury and illness incidence rates by case type, private industry, 2003-2012



by employment size, private industry, 2008-2012




Distribution of nonfatal occupational injury and illness cases
by category of illness, private industry, 2012





Distribution of nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses by private industry sector, 2012




Incidence rates and numbers of nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses by private industry sector, 2012




Incidence rates and numbers of nonfatal occupational injuries by private industry sector, 2012




Incidence rates and numbers of nonfatal occupational illnesses by private industry sector, 2012




Incidence rates of nonfatal occupational injury and illness cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction, by private industry sector, 2012




Number of nonfatal occupational injury and illness cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction, by private industry sector, 2012



Selected industries reporting 100,000 or more nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses, all ownerships, 2012




Distribution of nonfatal occupational injury and illness cases and employment by ownership, 2012






Nonfatal occupational injury and illness incidence rates by case type and ownership, 2012




Incidence rates and numbers of nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses
