

## Colorado Springs Area Economic Summary


Over-the-year changes in employment on nonfarm payrolls and employment by major industry sector






Over-the-year change in the <u>prices paid by urban</u> <u>consumers</u> for selected categories






## Average annual spending and percent distribution for selected categories

Over-the-year changes in the selling <u>prices received by producers</u> for selected industries nationwide





