

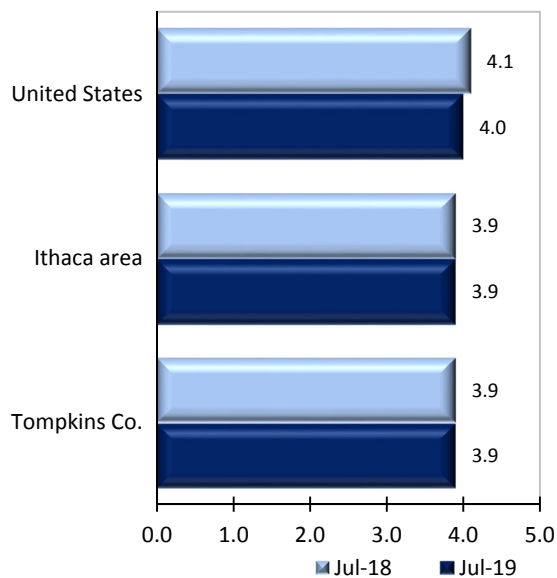
Ithaca Area Economic Summary

Unemployment rates for the Ithaca area, selected area counties, and the nation

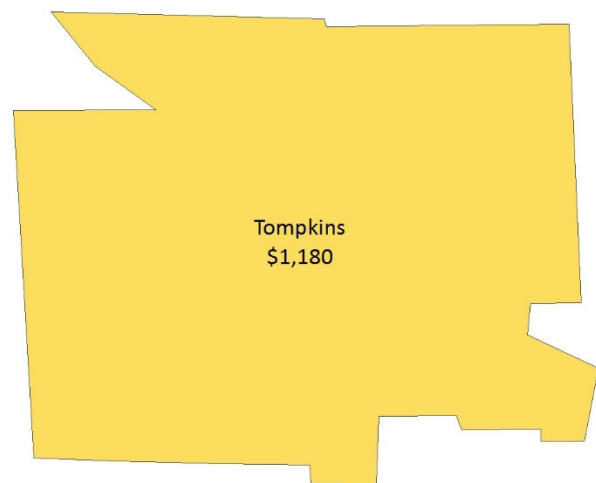
Unemployment rates

Average weekly wages for all industries by county

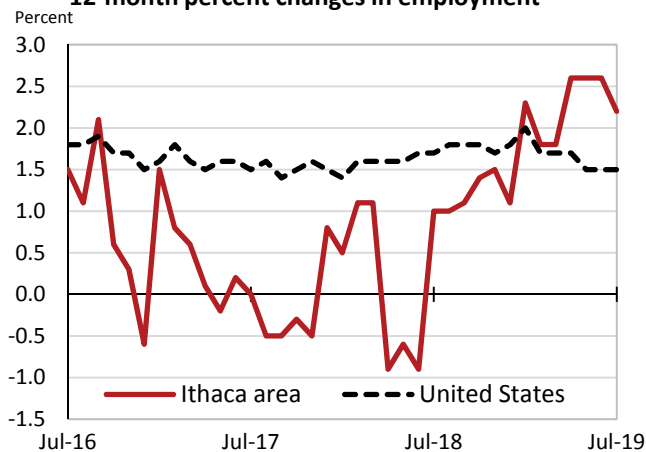
Ithaca area, 4th quarter 2018

12-month percent changes in employment

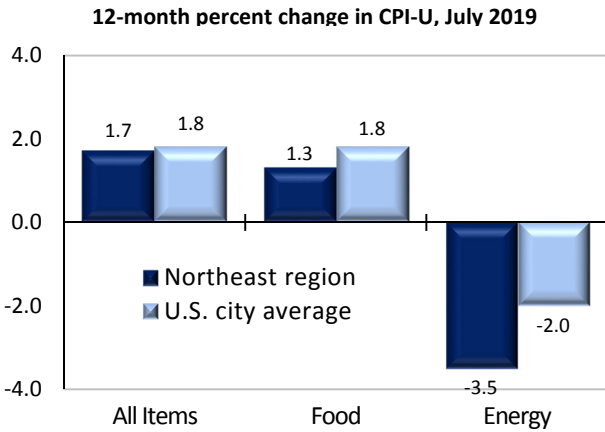

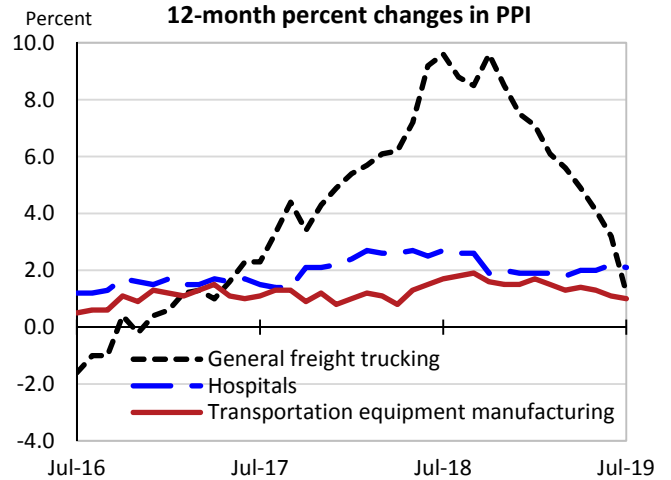

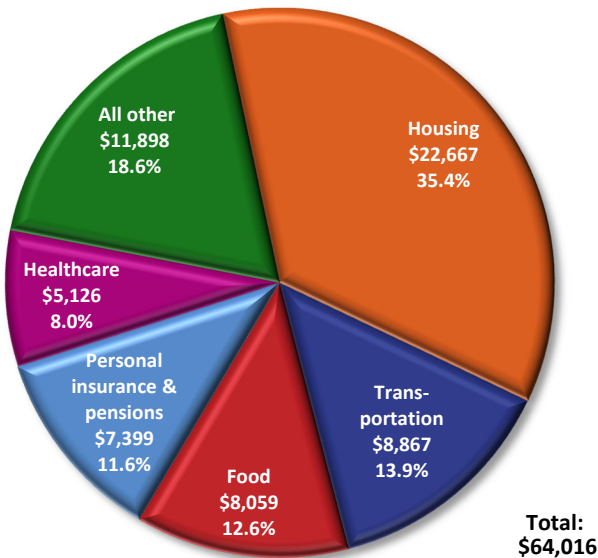
Over-the-year changes in the selling prices received by producers for selected industries nationwide

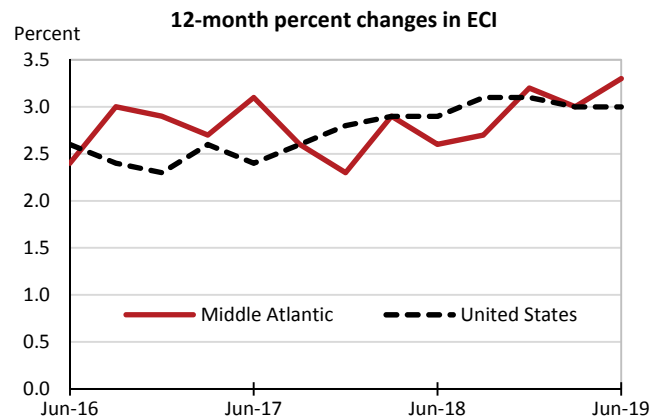
